Day 1 Sunday, November 30, 2014	Ask God to prepare the hearts of those who will hear His Story.	Romans 6: 13 "Give yourselves to God...surrender your whole being to him to be used for righteous purposes."
Day 2 Monday, December 1, 2014	We pray for those who will be telling the story.	Acts 4: 29 "Now, Lord... enable your servants to speak your word with great boldness."
Day 3 Tuesday, December 2, 2014	Praise God for speaking to us through the Bible.	Hebrews 4: 12a "For the Word of God is living and active..."
Day 4 Wednesday, December 3, 2014	Ask the Lord for guidance as we seek Him.	Psalms 61:1-2 God listen to me shout, bend an ear to my prayer. When I'm far from anywhere, down to my last gasp, I call "Guide me up High Rock Mountain!"
Day 5 Thursday, December 4, 2014	Thank God for our small group leaders.	Ephesians 4:11-12 "It was he who gave some to be apostles, some to be prophets, some to be evangelists, and some to be pastors and teachers, to prepare God's people for works of service so that the body of Christ may be built up..."
Day 6 Friday, December 5, 2014	Pray that this Story experience will lead us to truth, freedom and hope.	John 8:31-32 "Jesus said, 'If you hold to my teaching, you are really my disciples. Then you will know the truth and the truth will set you free.'"
Day 7 Saturday, December 6, 2014	Confess our lack of attention to His word.	James 1:22 "Do not merely listen to the word, and so deceive yourselves. Do what it says."
Day 8 Sunday, December 7, 2014	Pray for our friends and family as we share God's story with them.	Psalms 145:4 "One generation will commend your works to another; they will tell of your mighty acts."
Day 9 Monday, December 8, 2014	Pray for spiritual growth in our church.	Hebrews 6:1a "Therefore let us leave the elementary teachings about Christ and go on to maturity..."

Day 16 Monday, December 15, 2014	Praise God for His Holy Spirit who guides us.	John 16:13 "But when he, the Spirit of truth, comes, he will guide you into all truth."
Day 17 Tuesday, December 16, 2014	Pray for families as they experience The Story of the Bible together.	Deuteronomy 6:6-7 "These commandments that I give you today are to be upon your hearts. Day 32 Wednesday, December 31, 2014	Pray that participants will have a renewed desire to pursue spiritual habits in their lives. Day 34 Friday, January 2, 2015	Praise God for the hearts that will be changed by this study.	Psalms 51:10 Create in me a pure heart, O God, and renew a steadfast spirit within me.
Day 35 Saturday, January 3, 2015	Ask God to powerfully use The Story to impact our community.	Matthew 28:20 "Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always..."
Day 36 Sunday, January 4, 2015	Pray that everyone will grow in their love of God – with all their heart, soul, and mind.	Matthew 22:37 "Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind.' This is the first and greatest commandment."
Day 37 Monday, January 5, 2015	Ask God to maintain unity and harmony among leaders and participants.	John 17:23 "May they [believers] be brought to complete unity to let the world know that you sent me and have loved them even as you have loved me."
Day 38 Tuesday, January 6, 2015	Pray for lasting, eternal fruit.	Matthew 5:48 "In a word, what I'm saying is, Grow up. You're kingdom subjects. Now live like it. Live out your God-created identity. Live generously and graciously toward others, the way God lives toward you."
Day 39 Wednesday, January 7, 2015	Pray that guests to our church will be warmly welcomed.	Hebrews 13:1-2 "Let love of the brethren continue. Do not neglect to show hospitality to strangers, for by this some have entertained angels without knowing it."
